



Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA)

Subject: Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 3)

Reference is made to the Announcement of Bangkok Metropolitan Administration on the subject of “Order of Temporary Closure of Premises” dated 21st March 2020 with the approval of the BMA Committee of the Communicable Diseases for restraining the epidemic of Coronavirus Diseases 2019 (COVID-19) which is a dangerous communicable disease, limiting public gatherings or preventing public meetings to avoid large scale outbreak.

In order that the definition of premises closing temporarily according to the above-mentioned announcement is clearly understood and that the premise owners, who are ready to cooperate and become socially responsible by being a part of the efforts to restraint COVID-19 epidemic, are able to act accordingly to the Order, amendments were made on Clause 1 and Clause 2 of the Announcement of Bangkok Metropolitan Administration on the subject of “Temporary Closure of the Premises” dated 21st March 2020 as follows:

1. Restaurants including restaurant located in commercial buildings, food stalls and hawkers (to be opened for delivery and takeaways to be eaten off the premises and hotel restaurants are available only for the hotel guests or for delivery and takeaway), except the restaurants and food courts at airports.

2. Shopping malls including shopping centers and community malls, except supermarkets, drug stores, or miscellaneous stores for necessary items, restaurants (available for delivery and takeaways only), excluding financial banking zones.
