

## Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) Subject: Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 19)

Reference is made to the Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) on Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 18) dated 30<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

In order to prevent the spread of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19), by the virtue of Section 35 (1) of the Communicable Diseases Act B.E. 2558 (2015), and Regulation Issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No. 15) dated 25<sup>th</sup> December 2020, (No. 16) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2021 and (No.18) dated 29<sup>th</sup> January 2021, Governor of Bangkok, with the approval of the BMA Committee on the Communicable Diseases as stated in the Meeting Resolution No. 4/2564 dated 29<sup>th</sup> January 2021, shall have <u>additional</u> premises <u>temporarily closed</u> as follows:

1. Nurseries, only ones located in Bang Bon District, Phasi Charoen District, and Nong Khaem District (except admission for overnight stay as regularity);

2. Early childhood development centers and preschool child development centers, only ones located in Bang Bon District, Phasi Charoen District, and Nong Khaem District.

This Order shall take effect from 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2021 onwards.
