



## Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA)

### Subject: Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 27)

Reference is made to the Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) on Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 25) dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2021, and (No. 26) dated 30<sup>th</sup> April 2021.

As the number of new COVID-19 confirmed cases is still high; therefore, the BMA Communicable Diseases Committee has resolved that it is deemed appropriate to further implement urgently crucial prevention measures for venues, business or activities so that they can be opened for operations under conditions, time clause, systematic arrangement and regulations as well as disease prevention measures as prescribed by the Government for the maximum and strict control area in compliance with the Regulation Issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No. 22) dated 29<sup>th</sup> April 2021 in order that the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 can be ended quickly.

By the virtue of Section 35 (1) of the Communicable Diseases Act B.E. 2558 (2015), and Regulation Issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No. 20) dated 16<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and (No.22) dated 29<sup>th</sup> April 2021, Governor of Bangkok, with the approval of the BMA Communicable Diseases Committee as stated in the Meeting Resolution No. 12/2564 dated 7<sup>th</sup> May 2021, shall have the order for temporary closure of premises and enforcement of measures as stated in the Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) on Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 25) dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and (No. 26) dated 30<sup>th</sup> April 2021 until 17<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

In case where the Announcement of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) on Order of Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 25) dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2021 is contrary or inconsistent with (No. 26) dated 30<sup>th</sup> April 2021, the latter Announcement shall have overriding effects over the previous one.

Any persons who violate or fail to comply with this Order shall be guilty of an offense under Section 52 of the Communicable Diseases Act B.E. 2558 (2015) which shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand Baht or to both and shall be guilty of an offense under Section 18 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation B.E. 2548 (2005) which shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to a fine not exceeding forty thousand Baht or to both.

As this is a case where there is urgent necessity and the delay of action may cause great harm to any individual or affect the public interest, litigants shall not be given the right to object under section 30 paragraph two (1) of the Administrative Procedure Act, B.E. 2539 (1996).
